

Personal Prayer Guide

1st June - 7th June 2026

1 Adoration

Worthy are you, our Lord and God,
to receive glory and honour and power,
for you created all things,
and by your will they existed and were created.
Revelation 4:11 (ESV)

Praise God in prayer for his worthiness. Worship him in prayer, giving him all the glory, honour, and power. Praise him for our salvation through Jesus Christ, glorifying him as our creator and the giver of life.

2 Confession

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves,
and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins,
he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to
cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
1 John 1:8-9 (ESV)

Use this verse to guide you in your prayer of confession. Ask the Holy Spirit to search your heart and reveal areas in your life where you need to repent, and bring them before God. These could be areas of pridefulness, lack of trust in God, or worldliness. Bring them before the Lord and trust his faithfulness to forgive you through Christ.

3 Thanksgiving

Use Psalm 100 and thank God for being our great shepherd. As you pray:

- Thank God for being our creator who made us, and that we are his people, the sheep of his pasture;
- Thank God for his steadfast love that endures forever;
- Thank God that he is faithful to all generations;
- Ultimately thank God for your salvation through the wonderful work done on the cross by our Lord Jesus Christ.

4 Petition (for yourself and your household)

And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. Joshua 24:15 (ESV)

Pray that you and your household will faithfully serve the Lord and bring any of your personal or family needs before God.

5 Petition (for God's household, the church)

Pray today for our Elders using the prayer and prompts below.

May our leaders be pure with spiritual aims and intentions; serving not their own honour and interest, but yours. May our leaders show sincerity, not appearing outwardly spiritual while being inwardly carnal. May our leaders be diligent, like men in harvest, like women in labour, like soldiers in battle, watching while others sleep. (John Flavel)

Pray also that our Elders would:

- Continue to seek the wisdom of God, longing to glorify him and him alone;
 - Continue to remain faithful to Scripture as they lead;
 - Remain united in Christ, and filled with the Spirit as they strive to shepherd the church well.
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6 Petition (for the world)

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age. Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV)

Pray for anyone you may know who is not a believer yet. Perhaps it is an unbelieving friend, colleague, or family member. Pray for them by name, that they would accept Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. Pray that you would remain faithful to fulfill the Great Commission, given to all believers.
